When our children were somewhat younger than they are now, it was quite common in our house for the phrase, "That's it! Christmas is cancelled." to be shouted out. That's not a phrase that has been used much over recent years although we have spotted that the press have been using the headline "Christmas is Cancelled" because of the coronavirus pandemic. Meanwhile, our Prime Minister has been advising us to follow the rules during the second lockdown in an attempt to "Save Christmas".

But why does Christmas need saving? Yes, we do value our family gatherings at this time of year; many of us will miss out on the usual office parties and other social gatherings. In the Church, we are disappointed not to be able to bring the community together in the same way as we usually do for the singing of carols and sharing of festive greetings.

When the shout of 'Christmas is cancelled' echoed around our house all those years ago, it was followed by another cry of 'You can't cancel Christmas - it will happen anyway.' It is not Christmas that needs saving through our efforts, as our Prime Minister suggested; but rather that we are saved because of God's gift given on that first Christmas night.

The birth of the Son of God, which we celebrate during this season, brings God's saving grace to all who will put their trust in him. OK, we may not be able to gather in our Churches this Christmas time, and we may not be able to welcome friends and family to join us around our tables for Christmas lunch; but we can welcome Jesus Christ to be with us this Christmas time and, if we let him, for all eternity.

Merry Christmas to you all and let's look forward to a fabulous 2021 and whatever it brings.

For your safety and the safety of others, face coverings must be worn by all who are not exempt from doing so. Please be prepared to queue outside the Church until you are shown to a seat (which may not be your usual one). Strict social distancing between households/support bubbles will be in place. And as much as we would want to greet one another with a handshake, warm hug or a kiss, that won't be possible either. Please follow any one way system that is in place in Church and make use of the hand sanitiser at the entrance and exit of the Church. Currently we are not permitted to sing in Church so our services will not include hymns at this time. We are not allowed to serve refreshments after the service and that is probably just as well as access to the toilet will not be possible either. And for some good news: We can now turn the Church heating on to help keep you a little warmer.

Finally, we would ask you to choose which church you will attend and not switch between different congregations as this will help to reduce the risk of virus transmission. You may think that these measures will spoil your worshipping experience, but we are so looking forward to gathering in a building that has been a place of prayer and spiritual support in the village for so many people over many years. # Chrístmas Candy Canes



What do you put on your Christmas tree? Along with ornaments that I have collected over the years I always have some candy canes, mainly because I like to eat them! But candy canes can also remind us about Jesus. The white reminds us of the virgin birth and that Jesus has no sin. The red stripes remind us of the sacrifice Jesus made for us by dying on the cross. The shape of a candy cane is a J -if you turn it the right way round - which of course reminds us that Jesus is the name of the man who came to earth as a baby and became our Saviour. Then if you turn the candy cane back, it becomes a crook, reminding us that Jesus is our shepherd and we are His sheep. Perhaps you

could have some candy canes on your tree this year, but instead of putting them all on your tree, save one and give it to a friend to help them remember what Christmas is truly about.




