The barbecue will only be used in accordance with manufacturers guidelines and will be 'fenced off' behind tables to prevent accidental injury. Any burns to be treated immediately with cold water in the kitchen and seek medical assistance if necessary.	L	M		
Weather related issues	Everyone	L	In the case of extreme heat, drinking water will be made available. A gazebo will be available to provide shade for the barbecue and chef if the sun is strong. Everyone, including all team members to be responsible for their own sun protection. If it rains, the Church will remain open for people to use as a shelter.	L	L		
Garden Games	Everyone	L	Team members to monitor the use of these games and remind parents to be responsible for their children at all times.	L	L		
General accidents slips, trips, falls stings, cuts, splinters.	Everyone	L	First aid trained personnel will be available if required. A first aid kit is available opposite the table store. All accidents/incidents to be recorded in the Accident Book.	L	L
